January 2022 experienced tornadoes, record high temperatures, and snowfall all in the matter of the first few days of 2022. The rest of January, however, was generally colder and drier than normal.

Statewide, January's monthly average temperature was 1.2°F colder than the long-term average of 45.1°F. January typically reports the coldest daily and monthly temperatures of winter. This January is making a strong case for the 2021-22 cold season. Several stations sank into the teens during 22nd to 23rd timeframe with two stations, one in Haleyville and one in Russellville, bottoming out at 14°F. While January was cold overall, it did record some daily record high temperatures in its first two days. The majority of the reporting stations in Alabama broke/tied their daily high temperature record with the unusually warm weather on January 1st and 2nd, illustrating how wide-spread the warmth was. The warmest location of the month is awarded to a station in Greenville, AL at 87°F on the January 1st.

For the third consecutive month, Alabama endured drier than normal conditions at 0.49 inches below normal. However, this is a case where the average does not represent the whole state. While there were parts of the state that were drier than normal, many counties in North Alabama experienced wetter than normal conditions for the month. A station in this area, Cloverdale 6.6 WSW, recorded the most precipitation at 9.32 inches. The driest areas, on the other hand, were located in southwest Alabama including a station in Elberta that recorded only 1.59 inches of precipitation which was the driest location this month.

From a monthly snowfall perspective many stations across central and north Alabama experienced anywhere from a dusting to about 10 inches. Most of this snowfall was due to a winter storm following on the heels of the record warmth, hitting Alabama on the 2nd and 3rd. The snowiest location this month was on Keel Mountain near Gurley, AL with an impressive 10.5 inches of snowfall.

As mentioned in last month's report, there is potential for severe weather every month of the year. January 2022 was no exception. Six tornadoes were recorded, three on January 1st in north Alabama and three on January 9th in south Alabama. Fortunately, no reported casualties or injuries on either date. As a reminder, stay weather aware and prepared.
