

After a very warm March, Alabama's statewide temperature settled in April to just below the 62.8 °F average at 62.0 °F. The average doesn't tell the real story though. The Gulf counties were 1.7 °F warmer than average, while the northern counties were 2.5 °F cooler than average. The northern counties' above average rainfall contributed to the cooler than average temperatures.

Andalusia-Opp Airport, our normal winner of the statewide hot-spot had to share honors for April's hottest daily reading with Dothan and Koptis Farms (Baldwin Co.) at 91 °F. An odd note about this value is that Andalusia-Opp rose higher last month, hitting 92 °F in March.

Freezing temperatures in April do occur and we saw 23 stations dip this cold. Russellville and a farm station in Madison Co. felt the chill of 27 °F mid-month. This will likely be the last freeze for this year with the northern counties average last freeze date on April 2nd. The rest of Alabama average last freeze date varies from March 3rd (Gulf counties) to March 29th (central Alabama).

Rainfall was 2.30 inches above the norm, with 7.11 inches statewide. For the last five months, the counties along the Tennessee River remained wet, seeing the 2nd highest total in 126 years of almost 45 inches. However, the dryness from March continued in April with the Gulf Coast counties recording less than average rainfall. For March and April Mobile and Baldwin Counties were their 12th driest in 126 years receiving only 4.87 inches compared to the average of 10.99 inches.


Holt Lock & Dam, on the Black Warrior River just above Tuscaloosa, captured the most water in their rain gauge in April – 16.84 inches. So, with the normal variations within the state, overall we were fairly close to average temperature-wise, and a bit on the wet side with regards to rainfall.



