

# The Alabama Climate Report

Traveling north to south in Alabama, February presented quite a contrast in terms of rainfall. Stations in the north were above 10 inches almost everywhere, peaking out at 16.33" at a volunteer's CoCoRaHS station in Madison. Fully 52 stations in Alabama endured over a foot of rain in this the calendar's shortest month. The last nine days of the month alone produced many double-digit totals. In fact, for many locations in No. Alabama, the winter (Dec., Jan., Feb.) rainfall was the record wettest since 1895, with amounts coming in at over 30", almost twice the normal of 16".

Meanwhile, as one moved south, the numbers dropped off considerably, with February values less than 2" in Montgomery as well as at stations around the Mobile Bay area. Before rains fell at the end of the month and in the first week of March, I was close to recommending "Abnormally Dry" or "D0" for the weekly U.S. Drought Monitor.

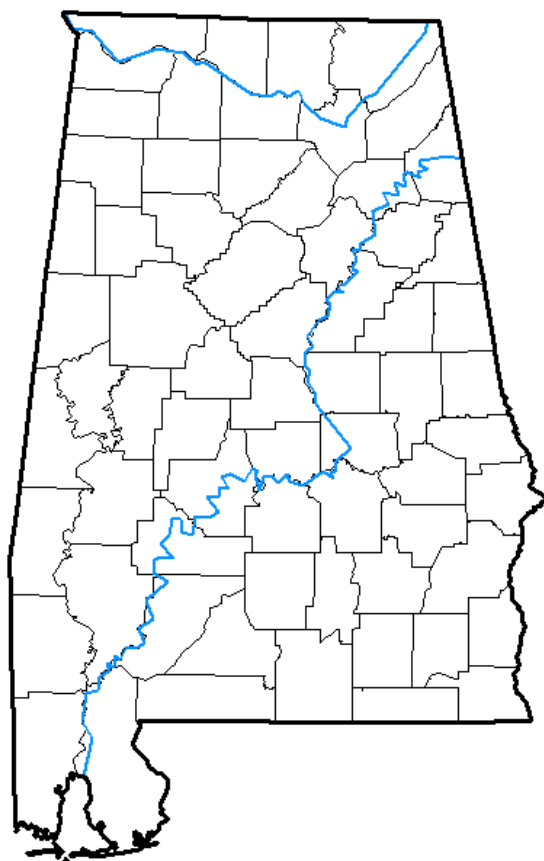
Temperatures were relatively mild, the coldest being a bearable 20°F in Addison, Belle Mina, Hamilton, and Owens Cross Roads. Indeed, 23 of our southern stations did not fall below freezing this past month. And, Jackson topped the state at 91°F with 12 stations reporting at least 85°F as their hottest day. Indeed, Montgomery hit record territory at 86°F on the 22nd which was their warmest winter day since records began there in 1873.

As I write this, the rebuilding efforts in Beauregard are just beginning. The tornado was classified as EF4, the strongest tornado in the entire country over the last 22 months, and the worst tornado-day for Alabamians since 2011. UAH's considerable severe-weather research team is looking closely at this event as they gain knowledge and understanding to better-warn and better-prepare our citizens for these rare, but destructive events. To those affected and those offering assistance we desire endurance and hope in this difficult time.

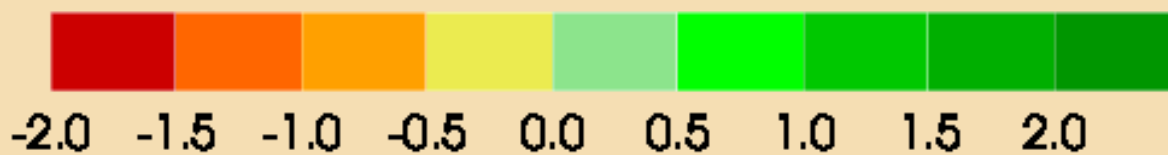
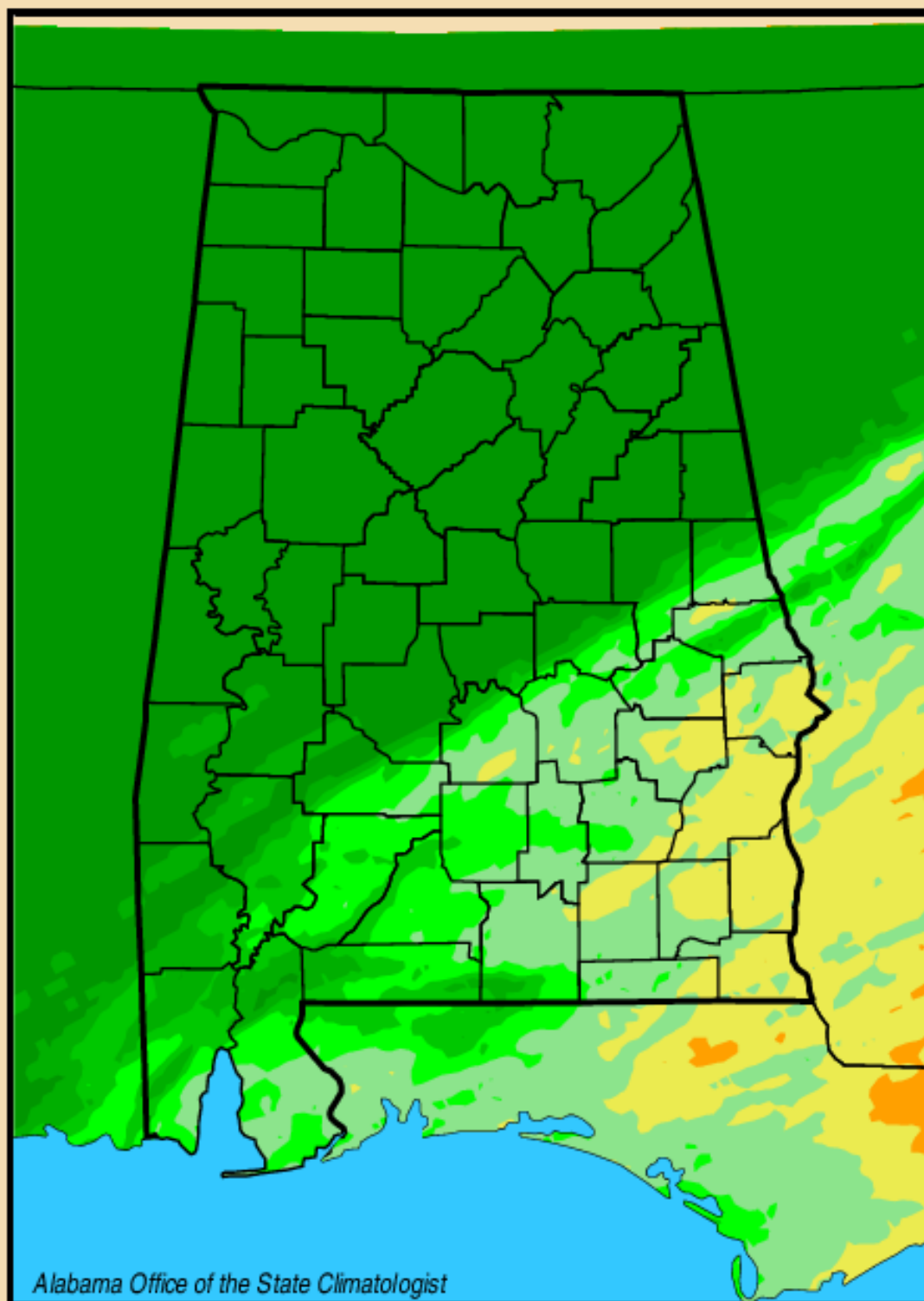
